Online Program

Four graduate level courses earning 12-credit hours

Admission **Requirements**

GPA: A minimum 3.0 cumulative undergraduate GPA in nursing coursework.

Education: A Bachelor of Science in nursing (B.S.N.).

Application Requirements

License: A valid and unencumbered R.N. license.

Resume/CV: Submit a professional resume or curriculum vitae.

Transcripts: Applicants must provide official transcripts from every college/university attended. Graduates from the **Hunt School of Nursing ABSN** program will submit the unofficial transcript.

Recommendation letters and professional essay not required. Invest in yourself and support your professional growth.
